




KMLA Tournament Rules

1. All games are played under the BCLA and the C.L.A. rules.
2. Minor penalties will be 2 minutes in duration during all games. Major penalties will be 5 minutes in length. Any player given a game misconduct also gets an automatic 1 game suspension. Any player given a gross misconduct, match penalty, 2 game misconducts or fighting major will be expelled for the remainder of the tournament. These decisions are not subject to appeal or protest.
3. All teams must be on the floor at the scheduled time. There will be a two minute delay of game penalty for any team not prepared to start playing at their scheduled time.
4. All games will consist of a 5 minute warm-up followed by three twenty minute running-time periods with a 5 minute break between periods. If time permits, the last 5 minutes of the 3rd period will be stop time if the goal difference is 5 goals or less.
5. Teams are divided into 2 playing divisions playing 3 games each with their division with all teams advancing to play on Sunday. There will be no overtime during divisional play. A total of 2 points will be awarded for each divisional game as follows:
 - 2 points for a game won
 - 1 point per team for a tie game
 - 0 points for a game lost
 - A forfeited game will be scored as a 3-0 win with the full 2 points awarded to the team in attendance
6. A tie in the standing after divisional play will be decided as follows:
 - Result of head-to-head game(s) if all teams involved have played each other
 - Best goal average as per Minor Directorate Operating Policy, Regulation 4, Playing Rules, "Goal Average – GF(GF+GA)"
 - Least penalty minutes
 - Coin toss
7. On Sunday a tie will not be accepted as the final result and overtime will take place as follows:
 - Teams will not switch ends
 - After a 1 minute rest, a 5 minute stop-time period will be played
 - If the game remains tied, the teams will play a sudden-victory overtime until a winner is decided.
8. The home team will be responsible to change jerseys if there is a conflict. Pinnies will be available at the main desk.
9. Any official protest shall be documented and submitted together with a \$100.00 bond to the Tournament Director, whose decision is final. The protest bond will be returned if the protest is upheld.
10. Coaches will be held responsible for the condition of the dressing rooms that their team's use. Any damages to the facilities will be billed to the association responsible.

11. Please leave the dressing rooms clean and neat. Pick up all tape, containers, etc. and place in the receptacles provided before vacating the dressing room.

12. Abuse of Referees, Game Officials or Tournament Volunteers **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED**, and may be grounds for expulsion of an individual or team involved, at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

13. Unruly fans may be barred from the tournament arenas at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
